

Adding Words and Topic Dictionaries in WordQ

To add words to the main prediction list:

- 1) Click "Options", then click "My Words".
- 2) Type the new item into the New word box.
- 3) Click "Add".
- 4) Repeat until all new words are added.
- 5) Click "Close".
- 6) Note: Be sure when closing WordQ to Click "Yes" to save the dictionary changes!

To make a Topic Dictionary:

- 1) Click "Options", then click "My Words".
- 2) Click the "Topics" tab.
- 3) Click "New" to start a new topic. Type the name in the box (i.e., Science Chapter One), then click "OK".
- 4) Type the new item into the New word box.
- 5) Click "Add".
- 6) Repeat until all new words are added.
- 7) Click "Close".
- 8) Note: Be sure when closing WordQ to Click "Yes" to save the dictionary changes!

To use a Topic Dictionary during writing:

- 1) Pull down on the Topic arrow to select the topic.
- 2) The words in the topic dictionary should show up in the prediction list.
